



Chicago Shoreline Marathon Contingency Plan:

- In case of high wind and/or waves with northerly component:

Marathon course will run between Leone Beach and Chicago breakwall equaling approx. 18 miles. Start would be at Leone beach heading east to turn buoy between ½ and 1 mile off shore. Course would then head south and enter Chicago breakwall at NE entrance. Competitors would head west and exit breakwall at W exit near Lake Shore Drive. Paddlers would continue north, stopping at North Ave. beach and Montrose beach. Finish line would be in normal position off Leone Beach. If deemed necessary, 2 Beach and relay event would be cancelled.

- In case of Small Craft Advisory but mild north side conditions and USCG approval:

All events would occur as in 'high wind' situation.

- In case of Small Craft Advisory affecting north side and USCG canceling of race:

If conditions for the following day were favorable, all course events would be delayed for a late start if possible. If a late start would not accommodate a safe event, race would officially be cancelled. Social events (dinner, party) would occur as originally planned and prizes would be raffled off.
